



The Meadowbrook School expects its students to dress in a manner which affirmatively reflects the high caliber and uniqueness of the school. Students are expected to be well-groomed and wear clothing that is appropriate for school, clothing that is clean, in good repair (no holes, rips, or damage) and fits well. Well-groomed and well-dressed students demonstrate respect for themselves and the academic environment. It is for these reasons that The Meadowbrook School has a uniform dress code for all the students.

Boys: Tops – white, maroon, or gray Meadowbrook polo shirts.
Bottoms – khaki pants or straight legged shorts (no outside pockets/cargo pockets).
Socks – white, black, gray, or maroon.

Girls: Tops – white, maroon, or gray Meadowbrook polo shirts.
Bottoms – khaki pants, straight legged shorts (no outside pockets/cargo pockets),
Meadowbrook plaid kilt or jumper.
Socks/Tights – white, black, gray, or maroon
Leggings – white, black, gray, or maroon leggings (no patterns) may be worn under the
kilts or jumpers.

Footwear: Sneakers or dress shoes. Sneakers must be worn for PE.

Optional for Boys and Girls: Meadowbrook logoed cardigans, V-neck or crew neck sweaters,
Or zippered hooded sweatshirts.

For All Students:

- All clothing worn in school during the day, including sweatshirts and sweaters, must be Meadowbrook logoed attire. (Outer Wear, like coats can be their everyday coat).
- All clothing must be clean and in good repair.
- Shorts may be worn during the warmer months, September to October and May to June. Shorts must be mid-thigh to knee cap.
- If masks are required, two should be brought in daily and be well fitting. They may be washable or disposable.

The Following DOES NOT Conform:

- Sweatpants, stretch pants, knit pants, running pants, yoga pants, or capri pants.
- Athletic wear, such as jogging shorts or basketball shorts.
- Maroon gym shorts.
- Visible long underwear.
- Shoes with open toes, heels, or flip-flops.
- Pants with stripes, exterior pockets, or logos.
