### **Education Pathways Service Learning Program (Grades 9–12)**

The **Service Learning Program** gives high school students the opportunity to earn service learning hours while gaining hands-on experience in an elementary school setting. Participants assist teachers and program staff with classroom activities, tutoring, and enrichment programs while developing leadership, communication, and teamwork skills.

Students in grades **9–12** can volunteer after school or during designated program hours to support younger learners in academic and creative activities. This experience allows students to explore potential careers in education, child development, and psychology, while fulfilling their community service or graduation hour requirements.

- Serve as positive role models and mentors for elementary students.
- Develop responsibility, organization, and leadership skills.
- Earn service learning or volunteer hours toward graduation requirements.
